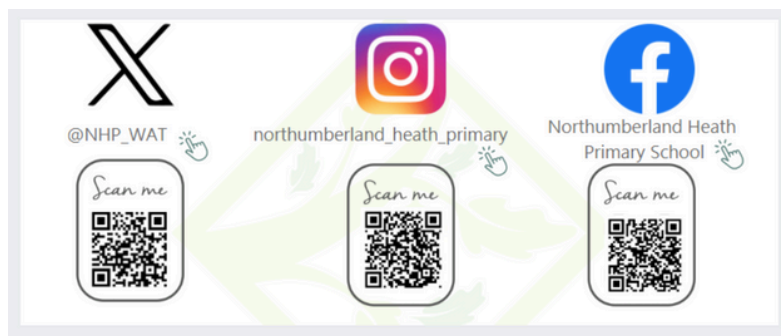
Our youngest children in the school, nursery are busy watching the caterpillars every day, anxious to see them turn into beautiful butterflies!

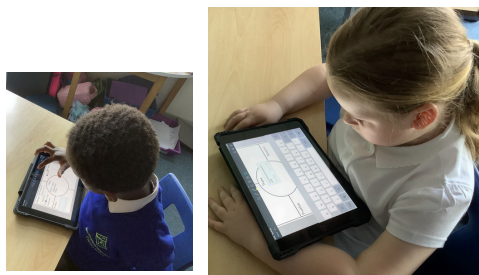

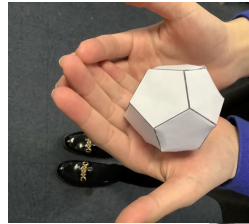
This week in Year 4, we have been using AI images and iMovie to create a travel vlog.
