

This week in Art, we have had loads of fun learning about how cave paintings were created. We really enjoyed turning the lights out and creating a dark room as if we were inside a cave We particularly enjoyed getting messy, using our fingers and feathers to create our animal pictures, just like they would in the Stone-Age.









This week in Year 4, we had our first competition of table tennis. The children loved playing each other and keeping score, and they even had a chance at being referee! We've also had a fun lesson debating if the River Thames is critical to human life! We created arguments for and against, and then had a whole class debate!
