Early Years



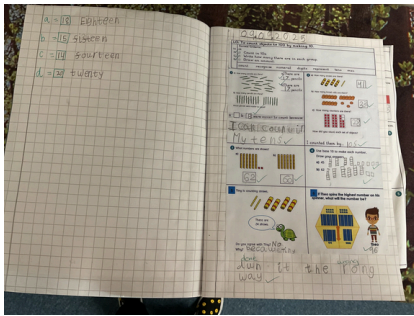

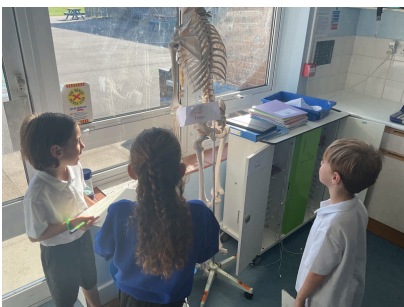
