This week, Reception have enjoyed their first forest school sessions. The children were able to explore the environment and use wheelbarrows to transport things that they found. Some children enjoyed looking at minibeasts more closely. Can you find any minibeast around the outside of your home? You can identify it using the internet, and maybe draw a picture too?

This week in year 1 we have been exploring the different parts of the human body and there functions. We have had group discussions in naming and placing the parts of the body. It was great to see the children learning through visual aids, and not only matching the body part but recognising the words.







Year 3 kicked off Big Band Day this week by boarding Flight Viva España. They created their own passports and sat back with an inflight movie all about Spain. On top of this, they researched about the physical and human geographical features that can be found in Spain and using their iPads made a presentation about the two different types of features. The children were then treated to a sightseeing tour of Spain by completing a scavenger hunt, had a lovely time learning flamenco techniques and created a piece of art inspired by Joan Micro! This week, Year Two were introduced to their new science topic for this term: 'Living things and their habitats'. We learned about the difference between living and non-living things and the criteria we use to distinguish between the two (MRS NERG- Movement, Respiration, Sensitivity, Nutrition, Excretion, Reproduction and Growth). We were then able to explore Forest School and capture images of living and nonliving things.











Year 4 experimented with iMovie and green screen technology. First, we learnt how to upload a selfie to a green screen. Then, used the new skill to record our Anglo-Saxon diary entries that we wrote on our Big Bang Day.

The children were really engaged in this task and enjoyed using a now resource to be creative with.





Year 5 have kick started their space topic this half term by exploring a range of astronaut training activities during their big bang day. They did some space station docking, rocket ship building and physical and mental training tests to develop their mental, physical and collaborative skills. In maths, they have been exploring multiples and used concrete resources to identify common multiples.

In Oak class this week, the children have enjoyed using Macro Bit code blocks to design a beating heart, a smiley face, and a rocket blast off animation. A special "well done" was also given to the whole class for their excellent behaviour during our trip to Erith Fire Station. The class were fantastic, and they learned useful community safety skills.
