Our topic this term is: All about me

Prime Areas

Personal, Social and Emotional

Development: We will be learning our school rules and class routines, how to be independent, using the toilet and getting dressed. We will begin to build positive relationships with both adults and children.

Communication and Language: We will be looking at similarities between ourselves and others. Learning about our different feelings and how to manage them in a positive way and learning to take turns and share.

Physical Development: We will be focusing on fine and gross motor skills which will include pencil grip, spatial awareness. **In Maths**, we will be learning to recite numbers and recognise numerals 0-5 through rhymes and songs.

We will be matching and sorting objects by size, shape and colour.

Expressive Arts and Design: We will be creating self-portraits using digital technology, loose parts and different materials to create representations of ourselves.

Understanding the World: We will be exploring similarities and differences of our families. We will be discussing where we live and who helps us.

We will start to explore Forest School after half term.

In English, our core text is What makes me a me.

We will be following Little Wandle Letters and Sounds to teach foundations in Phonics. We will be learning about environmental sounds and initial sounds in words. **Topic:** We will be talking about ourselves. We will look at similarities and differences and what makes us unique. We will be exploring this through supporting texts and teachers sharing information about their homes and families with the children.
