

Year 6 – Autumn 2 – Is there justice for all?



Big Bang Day will be on 05/11/25. Children will launch into new topics through immersive activities.

Maths:

This term, the children will be developing their understanding, fluency and reasoning in fractions, thinking about equivalent fractions, ordering, addition and subtraction of fractions.

English:

We will be reading the core text "The Soup Movement" which is based on themes of kindness, compassion and understanding of those around us. We will write an instructional piece of writing as an outcome, where we we will explore how to effectively engage the reader.

Science:

Children will discuss and explore the properties of materials, exploring this concept through a range of practical and exploratory activities.

Religious Education:

Pupils will explore how art, architecture, and charity express faith in Christianity and Islam.

History:

Children will explore the concept of "Is there justice for all?" with discussion of things such as: "What makes a crime a crime?" and "What is the Magna Carter"?

Physical Education:

Children will be developing their football skills as part of their outdoor learning and working on their gymnastic skills through indoor PE.

Computing:

Pupils will learn how websites are structured and why they are important for sharing information. They will design and build their own school website using Keynote, adding pages, images, and links.

Personal Development:

Pupils will explore respect, consent, and positive relationships through discussion and creative activities. They will learn about permission, boundaries, inclusion, and respectful communication.

D.T:

Pupils will learn basic cooking skills and how to prepare simple, healthy dishes safely. They will explore ingredients, follow recipes, and practise using equipment responsibly. Each activity helps them understand nutrition, hygiene, and how to make balanced food choices.

Music:

We will use Charanga to structure our lessons and link it to our learning in History.

MFL:

Pupils will learn to talk about months, seasons, weather, birthdays, and family in Spanish. They will build vocabulary through games, speaking, listening, and writing activities.

Trips and Visits:

We will be visiting St Pauls based on R.E, to explore Islamic and religious artwork.
