

Our topic this term is Significant Explorers.



In English, we are going to be using our core text 'The Journey' to explore settings and describe characters. We will be using rhetorical questions to engage the reader. We will be using our core text to create an innovated version of 'The Journey'.

In Maths this term, we will be looking at money and multiplication. We will explore the different notes and coins we use in the UK and compare different amounts. We will then explore multiplication through making equal groups and arrays. This will help the children learn their 2-, 3-, 5- and 10-times tables.

In Science, we will be learning about everyday materials. We will explore the different groups of materials, identify their properties and uses, compare materials and assess their suitability for different uses. We will then look at how we can reduce our plastic use, to help the environment.

In History, we will be looking at significant explorers. We will dive into the history of explorers such as Ibn Battuta, Matthew Henson, Neil Armstrong and Valentina Tereshkova. This will support the children when they are writing their innovated stories in English.

In Computing, we will learn about coding, internet search engines and logging into devices.

In Art, we will be looking at the history of portraits and build up to creating our own self-portraits.

In Music, we will be singing, playing, improvising and composing with the song 'I wanna play in a band'.

In Personal Development, we will be looking at communities and what different communities we belong to. We will explore how life has changed over time in relation to money and technology. We will then explore making the right choices.

In Spelling, we are following the Little Wandle Spelling programme. Children will learn about different spelling rules and spelling patterns to use the correct grapheme when spelling words.
