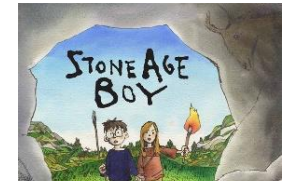


Our topic this term is Stone Age to Iron Age.



In English, we will use our core text Stone Age Boy to create our own portal story as part of our fiction writing. We will then produce a survival guide for our non-fiction writing piece.

In Maths, we will be exploring place value, ordering and comparing numbers up to 1000 and counting in 50s.

In Science, we will learn about what healthy eating means and how the nutritional value of the different food groups contribute to being healthy.

In R.E, we will explore the question 'What do different people believe about God?'. We will discuss how different faiths represent God in forms of art.

In Computing, we will learn about the importance of staying safe online and what e-safety means.

In DT, we will explore how mechanisms use levers and linkages to create movement in the various parts.

In Music, we will begin to learn about making music with an instrument.

In our Wider Curriculum, we will examine what life was like during the Stone Age and how that evolved over time using evidence from the earliest civilizations.

In Personal Development, we will recognise that there are different types of families and discuss how we can remain respectful to all of them. We will learn about the value of family units and understand what privacy and personal boundaries mean.
