In English, we will use our core text Toro! Toro! to create a conquering the monster tale using the tools of suspense and action. We will also be considering the ethical issues around bullfighting.

In Maths, we will continue to explore addition and subtraction before moving on to multiplication and division.

In Science, we will learn about what plants need to grow and what characteristics they share with other living things. We will also be looking at the life cycles of plants and plan our own investigation.

In R.E, we will continue to explore what people believe about God and to recognise that some people do not have a religious faith.

In Computing, we begin to learn about programming and coding and explore the uses of Keynote.
