Our topic this term is Romans



In English, we will use our core text *Romans* on the *Rampage* to create our own myth or legend and to write a newspaper report.

In Maths, we will be revisiting multiplication and division then moving onto perimeter and measurement before learning about fractions.

In Science, we will learn about forces. We will compare how things move on different surfaces and investigate how forces can act without contact using magnets.

In RE, we will be looking at why people pray in a variety of different religions including Islam, Christianity and Hindusim.

In Computing, our focus will be on algorithms and learning how to apply them when coding.

In Art, we will be researching the life of a mosaic artist and creating our own mosaics.

In Music, we are looking at Ancient Roman instruments and learning about Romans through music and song. We are hoping to share this with you at the end of term.

In our Wider Curriculum, we will focus most of our learning around the topic of Romans. We will find out where Rome is and how it was ruled. We will learn how the Roman Empire became so powerful. We will move onto discovering how the Romans conquered Britain and finally how Boudicca led a revolt against the Romans.

In Personal Development, we will explore family structures, truth, democracy and online safety.
