### Our Learning Overview

## Fish and Fjords

### English

In English, we will be writing our own contemporary fiction, around the theme of moving to a new place and fighting for something you believe in. In non-fiction writing, we will write our own biographies.

### Maths

In maths, we will be continuing our learning about fractions, and we will be begin to look at money and how it is used in everyday life.

### Science

In science, we will revisit some of the learning from throughout the year. We will revisit the topic of light and how rainbows are formed as well as plants, skeletons and fossils. We will learn about Mary Anning and the impact of her work.

### Geography

In geography, we will study the origins and area of Scandinavia. We will compare this to countries in the South West of England, looking at physical and human features as well as differences in climate, population and agriculture.

### Art/DT

In art, we will learn about healthy and varied diets. They will develop their knowledge of food hygiene and safety when using cooking and preparing utensils. We will be exploring Norwegian dishes and cuisine.

### RE

We will continue to explore the question, "What does it mean to be a Christian in Britain today?" We will explore how Christians show their faith in different types of Christian churches and how their beliefs fit into the modern world.
