Our topic this term is: Viking and Anglo-Saxon Britain.



In English, we will use our core text *How to train your Dragon* to create our conquering the monster tale as part of our fiction writing. We will then produce a set of instruction on how to train our own dragon.

In Maths, we will learn how to measure the area of a shape and record this accurately. We will continue to learn our times tables and use the facts in our area calculations.

In Science, we will identify appliances that run on electricity. We will explore what a simple circuit looks like, how a series circuit runs and construct one of our own.

In History, we will learn about who the Anglo-Saxons were, where they came from and what life was like in Anglo-Saxon Britain. We will explore the impact of their arrival on British culture and the division of the country into kingdoms.

In Computing, we will use different apps to create messages while understanding what to do if we don't like what we see online.

In DT, we will use our science knowledge to create a toy that contains electrical circuits.

In Music, we will begin to learn about making music with an instrument.

In Personal development, we will understand the difference between playful and hurtful behaviour, know what it means to be part of a team and begin to see how rules support our British Values.

In our wider curriculum, we will build on our prior learning about the Roman rule and demonstrate an understanding of the impact of the Romans in Britain prior to the arrival of the Vikings and Anglo-Saxons.
