## Our topic this term is: <br> The History of Medicine.

In Maths, we will continue to learn our times

In English, we will use our core text Bubble Boy to create our finding tale as part of our fiction writing. We will also use our core text to learn how to write an informal letter to the main character, Joe. tables and how to apply this knowledge to multiply and divide 2 - and 3-digit numbers. We will then explore how this can be used to calculate area and perimeters.

In Science, we will explore the topic of states of matter. How materials can change between the different states and then using this knowledge to create a fair test.

In History, we will learn about the History of Medicine. We will explore the lives of Florence Nightingale, Mary Seacole and Marie Curie and their influence on medical practices over the years, as well as the birth of the NHS.

In Computing, we will explore how to use the different features of the Maps app, as well as developing an understanding of what a computer network is.

In Art, we will be studying the work of artist Louise Young and developing our water paint techniques.

In Music, we will be learning some music terms based on the music of Harry Potter. We will also revisit chords learnt on the ukulele and learn some songs linked to the topic.

In Personal development, we will understand what it means to be a part of a community and continue to see how rules support our British Values.
