Topic Overview

During this term, we will be comparing and exploring the world through maps. Children will focus on map knowledge and skills, progressing in their knowledge of the compass by using an 8-point compass and understanding how to use an ordnance survey map to identify features of the local area. On our Big Bang Day on **Tuesday 18th April**, we will use aerial photographs to create maps of the school grounds, and then use these maps for our own treasure hunt!

- Maths	In maths, we will be exploring money; looking at change, estimation, rounding and ordering as well as using money in role play situations. We will be exploring time further, developing our skills in time duration and the 24-hour clock.
