

Our topic this term is Tudor Britain



In English, we will use our core text, *Divers Daughter*, to explore the range of emotive language and use these to write our own poems and a recount using figurative language.

In Maths, we will be developing our fluency and reasoning in place value. We will be extending our knowledge to numbers involving 100,000 and further. We are also going to explore both formal and informal methods of addition and subtraction.

In Science, we will learn the stages of the life stages of living things. We will explore the changes that animals and humans go through including how our body changes through puberty.

In History, we will focus on how the Tudor dynasty came to be and the impact it had on the kingdom of England, particularly with regards to religious change that happened across the Tudor dynasty as well as key events from the time.

In Computing, we will learn about the importance of staying safe online and what e-safety means.

In DT, we will be learning about and creating 3D forms specifically looking Nick Park.

In Music, we will be learning to play and perform in solo ensemble contexts, using our voices.

In our wider curriculum, we will develop our historical enquiry skills by researching how the local area has changed over time, investigate the Tudor heritage in our local community and consider what life was like in the Tudor Era.

We will discover the untold stories of the black Tudors and use this as a platform to explore their local community and conduct a geographical local area study of Royal Greenwich Park.

In Personal development, we will recognise that there are different types of families and discuss how we can remain respectful to all of them.
