Our topic this term is: Ancient Egypt



In Writing, we will use our core text, *Cinderella of the Nile*, to explore the range of emotive language and use these to write a narrative using figurative language. **In Maths**, we will be progressing our learning in fractions, from adding and subtracting fractions and then applying this learning to decimals and percentages. We will continue to develop our times table knowledge.

In Science, we will learn and investigate the stages of materials in different forms. We will look at which materials are best insulators and explore how we can contribute to the reduction of global warming.

In History, we will explore the Ancient Egyptian civilization, considering how they lived, the importance of the Nile, what Ancient Egyptians believed about the God's and life after death.

In Computing, we will using Swift Playgrounds to code. It provides walkthroughs and demonstrates the core concepts of coding.

In Art, we will be learning about and creating 3D forms and collaboratively designing an Egypt death mask.

In Personal development, we will examine our attitudes towards others and the environment we live in. While exploring the right to live in freedom and individual freedom.

In RE, we will explore the question 'What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today?'

In our wider curriculum, we will learn and explore why the Egyptians built pyramids and gain a deeper understanding of the Egyptian empire and its geography.

We will discover the Ancient Egypt Civilisation. They will use this as a platform to explore the British Museum.
