Our topic this term is Victorian Britain.



In English, we will use our text *Rooftoppers* to learn about life in Victorian Britain and the world in general. We will chart the feelings of the main characters and use these to write our historical fiction tale and formal letter. **In Maths**, we will be building on our knowledge of fractions by comparing and ordering fractions with the same and different denominators. Children will then move on to multiplying and dividing fractions and whole numbers by fractions.

In Science, we will identify, group and classify animals, plants and microorganisms based on their characteristics. We will research the scientists who developed the classification system and how it is used today.

In History, we will examine the impact of the Victorian Era on Britain and its legacy. We will understand what the British Empire was under the reign of Queen Elizabeth I.

In R.E, we will discuss whether it is better to express your religion in arts and architecture or in charity and generosity.

In Art, we will analyse the life and work of a Victorian artist, William Morris. We will understand how pattern is developed within our environment, creating our piece of art to reflect this.

In Personal Development, we will continue to learn about the different types of relationships and understand what is meant by the term healthy relationship.
