Our Learning Overview

Lights, Camera, Action.

Writing

In English this term, children will be reading the work of William Shakespeare. We will consolidate our writing skills using persuasion, formal writing, and recounts.

Maths

This term, there will a revisit of year 6 maths learning. Children will be consolidating all the topics they have covered as a means of embedding skills. This will also involve improving their reasoning and problem-solving abilities through several maths projects.

Reading

We will use different reading strategies to consolidate our comprehension skills and children will apply their growing knowledge of retrieval, explanation, and inference skills. They will be improving their ability to read aloud with expression and understanding and show their love of reading.

Science

This term, within science the children will be consolidating the topics from year 6. This will include the circulation system and adaptation.

History

In history, our topic is about the history of entertainment. Children will be learning about Chinese shadow puppets, Shakespeare style theatre and modern Hollywood movies. We will be learning how this industry has changed over the years and how technology will affect its future.

Art

We will be exploring how to create props for stage design. We will be creating appropriate props to coincide with our end of year presentation.

RE

In R.E., we will be studying Islam stories, their origins, the morals, and their importance to the people of Islamic faith around the world.
